### 1 Download


Make sure the ASE file is downloaded from the BirlaOpus website to a location where you can find it later.



Ensure your application version is updated from 2018 or above


### 2 Open Swatch Panel

Under **Windows > Swatches**, a swatch panel will pop up.



### 3 Import Library


Click the flyout menu and choose "Import Swatches." Navigate to the place where you have stored the file.




 → The flyout menu icon is an option to import colour library.

Use the flyout menu to change between list view (to see colour names) and thumbnail view (to see only swatches).




# Illustrator

## Import BirlaOpus Colour Library Illustrator Ver: 28.3

### 1 Download


Make sure the ASE file is downloaded from the BirlaOpus website to a location where you can find it later.



Ensure your application version is updated from 2018 or above

### 2 Open Swatch Panel

Under **Windows > Swatches**, a swatch panel will pop up.




 → The flyout menu icon is an option to import colour library.

 → Swatch libraries icon is an option to import colour library.



### 3 Import Library

Click the flyout menu or library icon and choose "Open Swatch Library" then the "Other Library." Select the saved ASE file.



### 4 Usage

The library will open in a new swatch panel. Start by exploring the library by code or by name.




Use the flyout menu to change between list view (to see colour names) and thumbnail view (to see only swatches).

Select 'Persistent' in the flyout menu to make the library appear each time Illustrator is opened.



### 2 Open Swatch Panel



Under **Windows > Color > Swatches**, a swatch panel will pop up.
